Stop Trump's Attacks on SNAP, MEDICAID, MEDICARE

President Trump has proposed changes to SNAP eligibility that would drive millions of now eligible recipients off the program. Medicaid, like SNAP eligibility for immigrants, would also effectively end. Immigrants are being scapegoated.

He also has proposed to cut Medicare and Social Security after the next Presidential election if he is re-elected.

NYPD 911 members are not fully recognized First Responders. Currently, the legislation that would make them First responders is in two bills.

One in the House, the other in the Senate. These bills must pass Congress and then be sent to the president for his signature after they are reconciled into one bill. It is important to contact your House and Senate representatives - Ask them to support and vote for Bills: **"HR 1629 House-Torres"** and **"S 1015 Senate-Burr and Klobuchar."** We will notify you when it is time to telephone the President.
